#### 4. Sectional Cross Country Chairpersons will:

- Conduct pre and post season meetings.
- Review and revise sectional classes based on Section V criteria.
- Make reports to the Section V athletic council.
- Make arrangements for State Meet competition. (Busing, Meals, Transportation, and chaperones).
  - Conduct Sectional Class Championships.

• Attend State Cross Country meetings and serve on state games Committee.

#### 6. Section V Cross Country League Chairpersons will:

- Attend all Section V Cross Country meetings.
- Send information to all schools in their league: Cross country handbook Sectional classifications Sectional entry procedure Rules and regulations for sectionals Any changes from the games committee
- Help administrate Sectional Championships
- Notify sectional chairperson of any mergers, move-ups, or violations in their league

7. Rules and Regulations:

Section V Cross Country will follow National Federation Rules (Rule 9, sections 1-7) and all rules of eligibility found in the NYSPHSAA handbook.

8. Section V Cross Country Games Committee (Boys and Girls)

The games committee consists of:

**Boys sectional chairpersons** 

Girls sectional chairpersons

Chairpersons from each league

The games committee is responsible for:

- A. Organizing and conducting sectional class championships
- B. Conducting State Qualifier meet
- C. Determine how teams and individuals qualify for NYS championships
- D. Select a Jury of Appeals for Sectionals
- E. Determine policy and changes for the sport of Cross Country
- \*\* Any policy that requires the committee to vote shall use the following procedure:
  - 1. Each league has one vote for each team in their league.
- 2. League chairpersons may send a proxy vote with a designated representative .
- 3. Fifty percent of the possible votes constitute a quorum.
- 4. Sixty percent will carry the vote.
- 5. The vote of each sectional chairperson will be used to decide the outcome of a vote if needed.

#### 9. SECTIONAL ELIGIBILITY:

- A. May not start practice before approved starting dates set by New York State, Section V and Leagues
- B. Must follow state requirements for practice and participation (See NYSPHSAA Handbook)
- C. <u>Must run a minimum of six (6) contests</u> prior to Sectional (See appeal)
- D. Any modified runner moved up to varsity competition must be moved <u>up prior to 50% of their schools modified schedule.</u>

### \* All appeals must be documented and sent to the respective Section V Chairman and League Chairman prior to the Sectionals for approval. All appeals must be signed by the coach and the Athletic director or Chief school officer.

#### 10. SECTIONAL ENTRIES:

- The Cross Country Sectionals are an open format. All teams and individuals are invited if they have met NYS standards.
- The number of entries will be regulated by the Games Committee.
- Each team will be allowed to enter seven (7) runners.
- Entry form and athlete verification can be obtained on line (x-c link of section v. org).
- All entries must be received by 8:00 PM Monday October 28, 2019. Late entries must go through the appeals process. Changes in entries may be made up to 1 Hour prior to your race with Dave Yen.
- The <u>Sectional Committee</u> has the right to rule on all extenuating circumstances.

#### 11. SECTIONALS:

• Sectional sites will be recommended to the Athletic

Council by the Games Committee for approval at the April meeting

- Sectionals will be the first Saturday of November.
- Starting time will be voted on by the games committee.
- Starting line positions will be assigned. 7 runners on the line.
- Uniform Rule and Jewelry Rule will be strictly enforced.

Any illegal runners or teams will be disqualified. (no face paint or other distracting apparel will be allowed).

- Coaches are responsible for runners wearing the correct bib number on the front of their uniform and shoe chip.
- Scoring will be by Computer. Official results will be posted after each race
- Final results will be posted on the internet at the end of the day: **sectionv.org** website.

# • This is a Championship Meet! Coached are expected to Supervise their athletes. No footballs, frisbees, etc.

- Dogs and other pets are not allowed on the Midlakes HS campus
- . Do not tour the course before the day of the race. Midlakes High School is private property.
- No Bikes allowed on the course during the meet.
- All vehicles will be charged to park on campus.

#### 12. Disqualifications and Protests:

- All protests must be in writing, on form provided within <u>30 minutes of the conclusion of the race</u>. Protests will be submitted to the section chairman.
- Jury of Appeals decisions <u>are final.</u>
- All scoring correction of team or individuals placement must be within <u>48 hours</u> of the end of the meet.

#### 13. AWARDS:

- Trophy and certificate to team champion in each sectional class.
- Medals to the 2nd place team
- Patches to top ten (10) individuals in each sectional class. (15) individual patches in Girls Class D
- Patches to members of winning teams (7)
- \*\*\* Awards ceremony will be at the designated times.

#### 14. NEW YORK STATE CHAMPIONSHIPS:

- A. Qualifiers:
  - Overall <u>winning team</u> (8 runners maximum) and coach in each State CLASS A, B, C, D will represent section V. ( Boys D Representatives will be the winning team from the class D/DD blends).

\*\*\*No others without coordinator's approval.

• Overall top 5 individuals not on the winning team, in

each State CLASS A, B, C, D will be represent Section V.

• individual runners will be supervised by the sectional chairmen and section V chaperones.

#### **B. NYSPHSAA AWARDS:**

- Championships plaque and medals to winning team.
- Medals to top 20 in each race.

• T-Shirt to the top 10 runners on the Championships Intersectional Team.

• The <u>Sportmanship Awards</u> will be selected from the athletes on Section V State Team and a vote of league coaches.

#### C. Qualifying for NYS Federation:

- Based on performance in NYSPHSAA Championships
- Rankings throughout the year.
- Information provided by coach (Due by 11/13/19)

#### 15. ALL SECTION V CROSS COUNTRY SELECTION PROCESS

- The top 30 runners from the Section V <u>Blended results</u> will be the All Section V team.
- 1st Team 1-10
- 2nd Team 11-20
- 3rd Team 21-30.
- All runners on the Section V All Star team will receive a commemorative award.
